As far as the client remembers, Robert was born in Virginia. They lost contact with each other over 40 years ago. Robert had a girlfriend named Linda when they were last in touch. Robert and Linda may have gotten married.

RESULTS

- Dr. Robert Lloyd Richards and his wife Linda were found living in Charlotte, North Carolina.
- His current address and phone number were located.
- Linda's Facebook page was discovered.
- Some information was gathered from social media posts and other records to provide information about Robert's family, medical practice, professional achievements and current activities.

RESEARCH SUMMARY

Web Searches

Robert Lloyd Richards, who now appears to go by the name “Bob,” indeed became an orthopedic surgeon. He is a foot and ankle specialist at the Charlotte Foot and Ankle Institute in Charlotte, North Carolina.¹ His “about” page on the Charlotte Foot and Ankle Institute website states that he is one of the world’s leading foot and ankle surgeons. It states that Dr. Richards was born and raised in Arlington, Virginia, and that he completed medical school at Johns Hopkins. While Dr. Richards also treats standard patients, he is said to be a leader in the treatment of elite athletes.² He is listed as a top orthopedic surgeon in the state of North Carolina in a 2007 article in *Charlotte Magazine*, which also states that framed photos of famous athletes he has helped to recover from injuries decorate the walls of his office.³ Dr. Richards consistently receives excellent reviews from his patients.⁴



The couple appears to enjoy traveling. Based on Linda's Facebook posts, Bob has participated in a program called Doctors Without Borders, providing some needed surgeries in remote areas, and helping advance the training of other doctors in at least two other countries.

While she only posts 6-10 times per year, Linda has maintained a Facebook page for ten years. Her posts detail family vacations, holiday events, her children's activities in organized sports, and their successes being accepted to the colleges of their choice. Linda's Facebook posts also indicate that Bob and Linda have consistently looked for ways to participate in humanitarian service as a family. On their last wedding anniversary, Linda posted a copy of their 1978 wedding photo.¹²
